

THE 55TH INDIAN ORTHODONTIC CONFERENCE AMRITSAR

It surely implied on the 55th Indian Orthodontic Conference which was hosted by Indian Orthodontic Society from 24th – 26th September, 2021 at Amritsar. It was the most awaited national conference of the historic Covid – era and the first ever virtual annual conference which was held under the theme "Smiles 2021 and beyond: a prism of opportunities"

This annual virtual conference was organised by Dr. Jagpreet Singh Sandhu (Organising Chairman & a prominent Orthodontist), Dr. Amanish Singh Shinh (Organising Secretary & Principal, Adesh Institute of Dental Sciences & Research, Bathinda) and Dr. Sukhdeep Singh Kahlon (Head of Department, Sri Guru Ram Das

The 55th AGM was convened on 25th September 2021. The agenda was taken up to start the IOS elections and bidding for 58th IOC and 27th IOS PG student convention. Polling started at 11 am and more than 2500 members of the IOS participated in the online remote elections.

The AGM reconvened at 2 pm to take up other important matters on the agenda. The President and the Hon. Secretary presented their reports. One major achievement was the regularization of the Vellore registration which the Hon. Secretary highlighted. The status of the IOS finances was explained in detail by the Treasurer and the balance sheet of the last financial year was approved. Detailed explanation

was given on the measures taken by the IOS administration to regularize IOS affairs in order to comply with Govt. Regulations.

The budget for the upcoming year was presented by the President Elect and approved.

The AGM also approved the

- Appointment of Auditors for the year 2021-2022.
- Appointment of IOS legal Counsel for the year 2021-22.
- Appointment of AGM appointed Committees (Constitution Committee)
- Arbitration committee
- Speaker Selection Committee
- Constitutional amendments passed in EOGM were ratified and the new IBO board of directors was announced.

Resolutions proposed by members and study groups were taken up and the challenges faced by the society i.e DIY aligners were discussed in great detail. An advisory committee was appointed to look into the complaints sent by members on Toothsi and the members of the IOS associated with it. In any other matter, the Vice President Dr.Suryakanta Das presented a proposal for an Orthodontic Practice management software.

The president announced the results of the IOS elections. The 27th PG student convention was allotted without contest to Terna Dental College, Maharashtra. Dr. Sarvaraj Kohli was elected unanimously to the post of JCO-IOS editor.





"MUSINGS WITH KEKI"

In Conversation With Dr Keki Mistry, Founder Member of IOS Episode 7

The bright rays of the October sun have started to warm the land and once again, I have the pleasure of sharing my whispers with you. So I draw up my easy chair and share with you a letter I received from Dr Vijay Jayade, a renowned and senior Orthodontist. I reproduce the letter below.

"Unravelling a "Mystery"



In the earlier versions of Microsoft Word, whenever I typed 'Mistry' it got highlighted as a miss-spell and one of the correct options suggested was 'mystery'. That is what Dr. Keki M. Mistry is to many young orthodontists. Being only six years junior to him, I think I am in a good position to unravel his persona.

I am not sure when exactly I met Keki for the first time. It might have been during my post-graduation at the Govt. Dental College in Mumbai during 1965-67 or it might be in one of the early conferences of the Indian Orthodontic Society. What I so distinctly remember is the first

impression he made – a tall, fair, handsome, urbane, suave, friendly and articulate person. In spite of his seniority and stature, he effortlessly mingled with us all. Besides being the founder member of the Indian Orthodontic Society, he was also very active (and continues to be active even today) in the affairs of the Indian Dental Association. It was a treat to listen to his speeches in the conferences or when he gave his opinion on any contentious issues in the Annual General Body. Everyone would hear him in rapt attention. His command over the English language, measured views and persuasive arguments would win the debate in most instances.

It was no wonder then that he quickly climbed the ladder of responsibilities, not only in IDA and IOS but also in international bodies like the Asian Pacific Dental Federation, International College of Dentists, Federation Dentaire International and WHO. Almost every year we kept on hearing his getting some award or honor. In spite of his achievements, he maintained cordial relations with his friends and colleagues.

He took up academics with the same zeal and perseverance when he joined the Orthodontic department of GDC. I remember visiting the Orthodontic Dept. of GDC after he took over. Earlier, I used to feel saddened to hear of its deplorable deterioration over the years, but when I entered the department with him, I could see a remarkable change. It had transformed into a well-equipped, disciplined and smooth functioning department. A galaxy of outstanding



orthodontist clinicians – some of them reputed present day academicians as well - came out of the department headed by Dr. Mistry. Later, I was also a co- examiner with him in a couple of MDS examinations and found him a fair and balanced examiner.

What I envy Keki for is the ease with which he interacts with persons of any standing – whether it is a minister, a cine star (even Big 'B'), a colleague, a student or the department attender. They all enjoy the same level of comfort with him. Consequently, he maintains a very large circle of friends and acquaintances. He has close relations with many orthodontic luminaries from abroad. The late Dr. Ricketts and Dr. Mistry, both devotees of Shri Satya Sai Baba, used to travel to Puttaparthy to receive Sai Baba's darshan.

This large circle of contacts enabled him to organize the IDA and IOS activities in a spectacular manner, whenever he was entrusted with their conduct. During my Presidentship of IOS in 1992-93, I requested him to take up the task of conducting a workshop on Post Graduate education in Orthodontics. He readily agreed him to take up the task of conducting a workshop on Post Graduate education in Orthodontics. He readily agreed and organized the activity in an exemplary fashion. He was able to attract a large number of teachers from all over India. The deliberations were thorough and fruitful. The arrangements were excellent. It was a most satisfying activity during my term and lion's share of the credit truly goes to Keki.

Keki will be shortly completing 80 years but at heart he is the same young person I saw all those years back.

Now he meets us every day on Facebook- sharing his thoughts and wisdom, complimenting someone's achievement, posting delightful photographs of nature's wonders and remembering festivals and important days of all faiths. He enjoys life and inspires others to do the same. I wish him many more years of health, happiness, active life and achievements.
