Indian Orthodontic Society presents MISSION EMBRACE - a social campaign, where underprivileged children and those from the low socio-economic strata will be provided orthodontic treatment, at no charge (to the patient), by the members (Life members & Associate members only), of the Indian Orthodontic Society, in their private offices.

Mission Embrace is a coordinated nationwide campaign, involving approximately 4000 Orthodontists across the country. The entire treatment, from the beginning to the end, will be documented in a structured format. The ongoing cases will be displayed on a dedicated website - <a href="https://www.iosmissionembrace.com">www.iosmissionembrace.com</a> and will be made available for the common man, who wishes to see the progress of these individual cases treated by specific doctors. For the layman, Mission Embrace, confirms the IOS membership of the doctor, and by extension, that he/she is a qualified orthodontist.

The underprivileged children or individuals will be from NGOs identified by the Indian Orthodontic Society, from NGOs or social organisations identified by local study Groups, or, from among the operating doctor's known circle. To ensure that the benefit of this campaign actually reaches the underprivileged, UID documents - like Aadhar Card, BPL Card, Ration Card, any Govt issued document, or the validation form the NGO/Social organisation, will authenticate the identity of the individual proposed for the treatment. The operating doctor, best ascertains the orthodontic need of the individual.

Mission Embrace serves, partly, to fulfill the social obligation of Indian Orthodontic Society (via its members), it simultaneously enhance awareness amongst the common man who is not aware that the orthodontic work is to be done by a specialist. People notice, when one is involved in philanthropy. With Mission Embrace, the 'one' is an ORTHODONTIST. The social media activity and other activities planned around Mission Embrace will surely help create a buzz. The bigger picture is that the profession gets to benefit. And as the bar is raised, all the professionals rise with it. It won't happen overnight. Consistency and patience is the key

The IOS machinery is making an effort at its end. The least that can be expected of its members, is, support, to make the efforts pay dividend. If the IOS members believe, that the best person to render orthodontic treatment is an Orthodontist - something which the IOS has been speaking out loud for some time now, it is time to prove it via Mission Embrace, where the excellence in the work of an IOS member will be there, for everyone to see. Provision has been made within the patient registration format of Mission Embrace, such that anyone seeking guidance, in the planning & treatment execution process, can seek the assistance of a guide - an IBO Diplomate, or, graduates with more than 10 years of experience, to bring out the best possible orthodontic treatment results in the case under treatment.


#### Braces for the pregnant lady!

Those planning a baby, decide upon having orthodontic treatment either much before, or, after the baby. However in instances where pregnancy happens while undergoing orthodontic treatment, the lady needs to take care on a few counts more than any other orthodontic patient.

The pregnant lady has no option, but to keep her gum health at its best. The hormonal changes during pregnancy make the gums prone to swelling. Not cleaning off the plaque and food particles from on and around the gums, teeth, braces and wires, can add fuel to fire, causing orthodontic complications.

The orthodontist must be kept in loop, about the pregnancy updates, so he/she may work around his/her line of treatment, to regulate the progress of the treatment around the rest advised by the obstetrician, or, by ensuring limited or no medication during the various phases of pregnancy, or, by limiting the amount of time the lady spends on the dental chair, esply in the final trimester of pregnancy, as the situation may demand.










#### Sathyabama Dental College, Chennai

Hello Dear Friends,

"Yakeen ho to koi rasta nikalta hai ,hawa ki ot bhi le kar chirag jalta hai" (Where there is a will and belief – there is a way, and then the lamp burns bright even in the face of gushing wind) - lines quoted by our Finance minister is true for public awareness programme "The Mission Embrace", Initiated by our IOS Editor, it has been a great social initiative where members of IOS members treat underprivileged individuals needing orthodontic treatment and making public aware of our speciality. The Union Budget presented this year and years before have neglected oral health, forgetting orthodontics where orthodontic material is no longer the social and health priority. As the matter stands, the orthodontic materials including buccal tubes, brackets and TADs have been included in drug pharmacopeia under Drug Controller of India inviting registration by the companies before selling any product in Indian market. The inflation in material cost will lead to costly treatment taking orthodontic treatment away from the common man. The

new NMC bill promulgated and the clarification by DCI regarding CDE points and short courses is also creating confusion. If an average health personnel without medical qualification can become a rural doctor with training of 6 months and is allowed to treat a common man,than what is wrong if an average dentist with 3-4 days CDE workshop recognized by DCI be considered a specialist in the subject. Are we not compromising with health of our citizens?!

The month of July saw two outstanding programs conducted under the aegis of IOS. Sathyabhama Dental College, Chennai organized 'Meliorism in Orthodontics' with 295 delegates participating in the deliberations. Excellent papers were presented on Orthognathic surgery and cleft anomalies. A 3 day workshop in Sri Amritsar was another captivating activity where Dr Stephen Chu conducted the course on Tweed Merrifield technique showing hands-on training extending even late in night. I thank Dr Shahul Hameed Faizee and Dr Sukhdeep Singh Kahlon, respectively, for conducting these CDE activities and sincerely hope that the students benefitted a lot.

The IOS Head office under our dynamic secretary and Joint Secretary worked tirelessly to submit all pending documents to Registrar office at Vellore, hoping the registration issue will be resolved soon. The 4th Executive meeting was held in Jaipur and many burning issues were discussed and sorted out. I thank the convenors of Rajasthan Orthodontic study Group for hosting the meeting meticulously.
