The 21st IBO Convocation Ceremony was held at the Bhubaneshwar Convention centre on 22nd November 2019. It was a very ceremonious occasion with the procession of the newly passed Diplomates taking the IBO pledge as they got inducted into the prestigous board. Dr K.J.Lee ,Professor, Yonesi University was the chief guestand he gave a very inspirational speech for the need to maintain high quality of orthodontic treatment to stay ahead in this competative era.Dr Lee also mentioned about the role of digital orthodontics in the future ,its advantagees as well as its limitations.

A new Diplomates directory was released by the Cheif guest Dr.K.J.Lee and recieved by the IOS President Dr.Pradeep Jain in the presence of Secretary IOS Dr. Sridevi Padmanaban.The Board would like to appreciate the efforts of Dr Vadivel Kumar for the same.

MEMBER BENEFIT PROGRAMS FOR IOS MEMBERS

Indian Orthodontic Society was started in the year 1965 with an important objective to promote and safeguard the interests of the orthodontists in India. The management Committee of IOS over the years had put in a lot of thought and effort towards that direction and established a separate program for the members called the Member Benefit program of IOS (MBP-IOS). The Committee on behalf of IOS had proposed two schemes for the members which were launched on 1-01-2020 after deliberations and approval at the 54th AGM.

Scheme 1:

IOS CARE – A MEMBER WELFARE PROGRAMME

This is a member welfare scheme where in the family of an IOS Life member gets a sum of rupees two lakhs as a fraternal contribution on the event of unfortunate demise of the member. The family of the deceased is paid this amount as a gesture of goodwill, a helping hand to the family and to send a message that IOS cares for its members. The Member need not pay any fees for enrolling to the scheme. The documentation part of the scheme shall begin very shortly and members will be communicated regarding the same. We request all IOS members to stay connected and keep their details updated on www.iosweb.net so that the IOS HO and Member benefit committee may contact you for necessary documentation and follow up.

Scheme 2:

IOS PROTECT- PROFESSIONAL INDEMNITY SCHEME

Orthodontic practitioners are increasingly becoming targets of civil suits for claims against unwary professional errors and negligent acts. To fight this malady effectively, IOS has launched "IOS- Protect" - Professional Indemnity Insurance for IOS Members. With "IOS-Protect" policy you are protected against acts that can go wrong during medical/dental care (including Orthodontic) as a result of which your patient is inadvertently harmed or perceived as harmed. It is a NECESSARY tool to financially safeguard medical practitioners against legal costs and claims for compensation by the patients in case of a legal row.

IOS has tied up with "The New India Assurance Company" for the Professional Indemnity scheme. The coverage shall extend to only members registered under the scheme. This Scheme involves an annual premium of a nominal amount(rupees 1077/member/year)specially negotiated for IOS members.

Sum assured

20 lakhs/year/member divided in to 4 incidents* of 5 lakhs each (AOA: AOY=1:4)

Steps for Enrollment

- 1. Visit IOS website (www.iosweb.net)
- 2. Download the Application form of IOS PROTECT
- 3. Transfer the premium amount online to the account mentioned in the application form.
- 4. Fill the application form completely and sign it.
- 5. Scan the duly filled application and send it to mbpofios@gmail.com to complete the registration process
- 6. The coverage starts only after the issuance of the master policy which will be intimated to the member. The coverage will be valid up to 12 months from the date of issuance of the master policy.

Request all members to avail this opportunity and enroll for IOS PROTECT and stay Protected. Kindly visit IOS website to know more about this scheme or contact the committee members for any clarification/assistance.




"Lingual Orthodontics Workshop"
