



What's the code word ?!

Once the patients start streaming in to a practice, the next logical step is to assign a code to each patient, for the sake of reference at a later date. The most common approach is, to assign a number to the patient. However, a number assigned, is a clue for an assessment officer to gauge the difference in the projected and presented figures presented to the authorities. Also, if practising at one office and nowhere else, it still might be okay. However, if one provides services at various locations, and would want the patients to be in direct communication, in matters related to the treatment, it would perhaps, be a good idea to devise a system which makes it easy to identify patients without stressing too much. An 8 digit patient identification system can be a handy solution. All patients can be coded in a YYMMLAB# format, where YYMM designates the year and month of case initiation L designates the location of the dental office, where the case is being treated

A is the first name initial of the patient B is the last name initial of the patient # is the numerical, to distinguish between patients with same initials started in the same month.

Beside being entered on the case card, the code can be entered on the cell phone with the YYMM as first name, L as the middle name and AB# as the last name. The study model box can be labelled with the code and all the wires, brackets, bands, etc. can be stored in one box to be retrieved on demand. The coding system, lets you know the exact number of cases you started in a particular month, the moment you type in the YYMM code in Search. Also, The Search of the L code can tell you the number of case starts at a particular
