What is speech? Sound is created as air passing over the vocal cords is manipulated. Further manipulation by the tongue, cheek, teeth and lips makes the words we hear coming out of someone's mouth as speech.

# Can teeth out of shape & line affect my speech??

If any of these elements are out of place, speech will be altered. While all the other elements are fairly constant, the one with the maximum variability is the teeth. A stream of air strikes the front teeth to make the "s" or "z" sound. Gaps between teeth or between the upper and lower front teeth, will cause "lisping" of speech as air escapes, through such gaps. Similarly, tongue will have less room to move with crowded teeth, causing "slurring" of words. Oral habits like thumb sucking, tongue thrusting, nail biting, teeth grinding and excessive bottle-feeding may lead to improper bite and thus speech problems which can make one conscious while talking to people.

Orthodontic treatment, by correcting the teeth position helps speech correction in a big way.
