

Prize distribution to the winners of different competitions conducted in YCDC was also done.


Day 3: Zoom Lecture session & Prize distribution







ORTHODONTIC WEEK CELEBRATION IN THE FRIGID AND DESOLATE LADAKH

Ladakh is home to some of the highest motorable tracts in the world and is till date not having any orthodontic treatment facility available in the entire region. I, Dr. Ashish Kamboj (LM-3072) consider myself lucky to be the first ever orthodontist to be permanently placed in Ladakh in the history of modern india. Considering the remoteness of Ladakh along with the lack of awareness in the local population regarding orthodontic care, a motorbike rally was organized on the occasion of "Orthodontic Week Celebration" in the frigid and desolate terrain of Ladakh. This was the first of its kind event ever conducted in the Union Territory of Ladakh.

The bike rally spanned over a duration of two days (3 & 4 Oct 22) and concluded on 5th October 22 with a lecture on orthodontic awareness to local Ladakhi population on the occasion of "National Orthodontist Day".

Day-1 (3rd Oct 2022)- The rally started from Nubra Valley and passed through North Pullu.

North Pullu is located at an altitude of 15,800 Feet and was the first stopover of the journey.

Our second stopover was at Khardungla Pass. Khardungla Pass is the second-highest motorable road in the world and is situated at an altitude of 17,900 Feet (appx).

Then our convoy of bikes moved towards South Pullu which was our third stopover in the journey and is situated at an altitude of 15,300 Feet. In South Pullu HPCL has placed its highest KSP in the world.

From South Pullu we marched towards our final destination which was Leh. We reached Leh in the late afternoon of Day-1.

Day-2 (4th Oct 2022)- On the second day of the motorbike rally the places visited in the first half of the day were-

- Shanti Stupa
- Leh City
- Magnetic Hill (via NH-1)

In the second half of the day the places covered were

- Choglamsar
- Changla Pass (Changla Pass is the third-highest motorable road in the world and is situated at an altitude of 17,600 Feet appx)
- From Changla Pass back to Leh in the evening

So, our bike rally concluded on 4th Oct 22 in the evening at Leh and in this rally we covered both the Khardungla Pass and the Changla Pass which are the world's 2nd & 3rd highest motorable roads in the world.

Day-3 (5th Oct 2022)- On the occasion of National Orthodontist Day on 5th Oct 22, an Orthodontic Awareness Lecture was organized for the local Ladakhi population in Leh. The lecture was attended by many and was widely appreciated.

INTERVIEW WITH DR KARISHMA PARKER

Dr Karishma Parker is a name most of us reckon with in our fraternity. She is not only an Orthodontist but also is one of the few female body builders who have represented India on an International platform.

She has won numerous accolades for the country including 3 gold, 2 silver and 3 bronze medals at National and International bodybuilding competitions.. She has recently won a Bronze medal in the Thailand Proquaifier competition.

She was also in the top 5 bikini body builders in a National competition held in Delhi. She is currently training for the upcoming International IFBB competition in 2023.

To know more about her journey and the struggles she faced, we on behalf of IOS times had a talk with Dr Karishma Parker, an international Bikini Body Builder, an Orthodontist, Clinician and Consultant.

Dr SA: Mam, welcome to IOS Times, can you tell us a bit about your dental education background?

Dr KP: I completed my graduation BDS in 2005 from Goa Dental College. In 2008 I stood 21st in the All India Postgraduate Entrance Exam . Since I was always interested in Orthodontics, I joined the Department of Orthodontics in the same college. I finished my post graduation in the year 2011 and went onto join as a Senior Lecturer in the same department for 7-8 months. Following that I started my private practice where I am almost completing a decade in clinical practice.

Dr SA: We all are actually intrigued about your interest in Bodybuilding. What motivated you to go for body building?

Dr KP: Well, the year 2015 was the turning point in my life when I had to go through a very tough phase in my personal life. Difficult times cause a lot of anguish and helplessness. You experience a loss in self esteem and you don't know where to start from. That's when you need the support of your family, friends and something to get a grip on and move ahead. I decided that the first step to moving forward was to get fit. I started gym just to lose weight and get a sense of self worth. But little did I know that it would be a life changing decision. My trainer introduced me onto the concept of body sculpting and nutrition. It was an exciting new concept for me and being a science student I thought of exploring it and studying it in depth. The rewards of this step was that I was able to overcome my mental issues, regain my self confidence and feel good about herself. That was when I fell in love with Body Building and decided to go ahead in that path.

Dr SA: I am sure you had someone to motivate you and support you in this endeavour...

Dr KP: Yes! I am fortunate to have a mentor in my father who never gave up on me. He is a self made man and has always taught me to stand up for myself. He has always had my back no matter what.

Dr SA: You know that there are not many female bodybuilders in India. How was the journey for you? Did you face any difficulties in pursuing a male dominated sport?

Dr KP: Though I come from an affluent family background, their outlook is quite conservative. To see a female doctor in bikini is a hard fact to digest for many. Infact, my father had to tolerate lot of sarcastic remarks and comments from his own friends. So yes, I had to fight a lot and work consistently to make my mark and to prove everyone that Bodybuilding is and can be a profession for females too. I hope I have been able change the mindset of some if not many.

Dr SA: Keeping aside the societal barriers which is something we all have to work on, how do you keep yourself motivated to chase your dreams?

Dr KP: Well, I realised it was my passion and I just couldn't live without it. Throughout the tough phase in my life if it hadn't been for bodybuilding, I would have never been able to lift myself up and move ahead. Also, It was in my character to never give up, the way my father had brought me up, a bit headstrong, to never rest till I get what I want.

Dr SA: That's a great asset! Can you share with our readers something about your daily routine and diet?

Dr KP: My routine keeps changing according to the needs and phases. Right now, I am in the Musclet gaining phase, so I go for a round of Cardio for around 60 minutes in the morning followed by two hours weight training in the evening.

My diet is usually supervised by my coach according to my need at that time. Basically, it consists of simple food items like egg, rice, broccoli, lots of veggies. I do not take sugar at all and instead use stevia which is a natural food sweetener.

Dr SA: Your journey has been so inspiring for all of us. Any motivating tips for those who are on their journey to becoming healthier and fitter?

Dr KP: You know, It all starts with thinking. It's all in the head. Once you think and decide then your will power will get you to your goal. I know it's tough for beginners but with practice you are going to get better. The most important thing you can do is Invest time for your Body and Health. Ultimately this is what you are working for or earning for. Nothing can replace good health. So prioritise your health and your life.

So go for it and Never Give Up!!


