

Dr Nikhilesh R. Vaid - past president of the Asian Pacific Orthodontic Society and the Indian Orthodontic Society has been elected to be the President - Designate, of the global umbrella of orthodontic associations - " World Federation of Orthodontists" - WFO. His term will commence in October 2020 after the 9 th IOC in Yokohama, Japan and will span a 5 year term until the 10 th IOC in Rio, Brazil in 2025. The entire Asian orthodontic community is ecstatic at this news. It is the first ever time a non American or a non European has been elected to this position. Dr Vaid will also be the youngest ever WFO President. The Indian Orthodontic Society President, Dr Shailesh Deshmukh states that the election of Dr Vaid to the post of WFO President, is not only a honor and responsibility bestowed on him as an individual, but also for orthodontics in the entire region. Dr Vaid currently chairs the WFO Boards and Promotions committee and is the brain behind the "World Orthodontic Health Day", a recent initiative of the WFO.

Practicing Orthodontics

Your Office

on the Globe

Gone are the days when, prospective patients would call up the office seeking directions and asking for landmarks to reach your office. In the era of smartphones, if your office is NOT listed on Google Maps, you already lost one brownie point, even before the patient has entered your office.

So how does one get his/her office on Google Maps?

For that, one must have a Google account. Assuming that you do have a Gmail account. Rest is easy.

- 1. Open Google Maps
- 2. Click on the three parallel lines on the top left corner to display Menu
- 3. Click on 'Add a missing place'
- 4. To add the place you are required to write the name of the place, set location of place on map and select best suitable category from the available ones.
- 5. Website, Phone, Hours etc though not mandatory, it'd be a good idea to fill in all those fields
- 6. Once you submit the information, Google will revert with either 'Google is reviewing your suggestion' or 'Your addition is Published'
- 7. If the mail says 'Google is reviewing' you need to wait for confirmation mail which may arrive anytime from few hours to few days.
- 8. When you receive Success mail, it will have a hyperlink 'See your addition' that points to your entry on Map
- 9. Now you and others can add pictures and other information about the place, if you'd not done earlier. You and others can also rate and review the place.

Once Google approves your location, the same is readily taken up by Ola, Uber and similar apps. So you



guide your patient to type your office name in the app for the taxi to bring him/her to you.

Assuming you are a visiting consultant to many dental offices, it would be a good idea to create similar locations for the dental offices. It would be useful in you scheduling your appointments at those offices. (Look out for the Dec 18 and Jan 19 issues of IOS TIMES) Word of caution - Use the dental office owner's Gmail account to create the location.
