### ACADEMIC COUNCIL AND CDE ACTIVITIES

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic that hit our country in the early months of 2020, all in-person academic meetings and events were cancelled. However, to continue and move forward with the proposed calendar of events, the events were shifted to an online platform. The first of which was the Ramachandra Orthodontic Accelerated Review (ROAR) in April of 2020, followed by the basic research methodology online webinar program held by All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi in the month of April as well. This was followed by the Orthodontic finish-line (revisited) online series by the Sri Aurobindo College of Dentistry and A-Z lingual orthodontics by NIMS university. An informative IOS webinar was also conducted with Dr MK Prakash and Dr OP Kharbanda as distinguished speakers in the month of May 2020. IOS celebrated the world orthodontic day by inviting 3 speakers on the online podium- Dr KB Kim, Dr Jorge Garcia Guerra. This programme was succeeded by Confluence 2020- 'Decoding dentofacial deformities' organized by the Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences and IOS PG orientation conducted by the Sharad Pawar Dental College. Following this, the first Orthodontic Innovation Conclave was held in October organized jointly by the three dental colleges of Puducherry. Other online programs included Airway management of OSA, the second online rendition of the ROAR, Orthodontic finish line organized by the MA Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences and Research, the JIOS symposium organized by the Sankalchand Patel University, Orthognathic and Orthodontic Surgical Symposium, a first of its kind organized by the Ramiah University and Orthosynergy2021- a national inter-disciplinary symposium with special focus on the "Rising stars" of the IOS; as part of the World Orthodontic day Celebration. In order to continuously engage our IOS family with online learning, the ORTHO MASTER CLASS was initialized and fructified by the Academic Council after due approval from the EC. The program was started in January 2021 and has had 5 exemplary lectures by world renowned authorities on a given subject matter- which included Dr Maria C Meazzini, Dr Martyn Couborne, Dr Anne Marie Jagtmann, Naphthali Brezniak, and M Elnagar. As vaccination pickups and COVID curbs reduce, we are hopeful that some of the future academic schedule may be in person or of a hybrid nature.

In addition to looking at the constitutional amendments proposed by members, it was also

thought to delink day to day routine things like conference protocols, scientific sessions, PG convention guidelines & study group guidelines etc from main constitution and keep them as separate protocol statements and with an idea to make the main constitution as a core document which need not be amended frequently.

**Along with the above, the other tasks taken up and completed were:**

Compilation of the amendments approved in EOGM and validated in 54<sup>th</sup> AGM, Review of the constitution for any omissions or corrections, Guidelines for CoC regarding procedural tenets, guidelines for newly allotted conference / convention on financial management and speakers. The members met on 21st Feb 2020 at the board room of Hyderabad International Convention centre (HICC) during the 24th IOS PG convention and discussed in detail of the compiled amendments and further guidelines.

The next meeting of this committee due to the corona virus Pandemic was conducted virtually on Zoom platform on 29th Nov 2020 for further discussions on proposals for amendments submitted to HO and same were forwarded to EC for needful and approval. AND THEY WERE the proposed amendments, constitutional amendments and bylaws were placed on the website for membership perusal and subsequent approval in the EOGM and AGM.

**Objectives of the committee**

The committee was formed with an aim to develop a thoroughly revised PG curriculum incorporating OSCE (objective structured clinical examination) pattern and all new developments in the field of orthodontics.

**Progress report**

As Dental Council of India (DCI) formulated a committee to revise the BDS as well as MDS curriculum and Hon. Secretary (Dr. Sridevi Padmanabhan) and Dr. N.R. Krishnaswamy being members of it, the committee has

decided to work with them closely and assist them in developing curriculum for orthodontic education in the country.



Dr. Bhagya Lakshmi worked closely with Drs. Kavitha Iyer and Dr. N.R. Krishnaswamy in developing conceptual problem-based learning curriculum with clear objectives as well as clarity for submission to the curriculum revision committee of Dental Council of India.

Dr. Asok Jena was very instrumental in developing case record format for PG studies, which is being finalized for scrutiny by expert panel.

### **Recommendations made by the committee**

The committee has recommended conducting nation-wide symposium for inputs regarding curriculum revision and formulation of new guidelines for conducting practical examinations taking into consideration the newer developments made in the field of orthodontics. The committee also recommends gathering a clear view regarding current practical examination procedures, so that it can be modified and adapted to the current requirements.

In the year 2019-2020; the committee started its work by streamlining the process of endorsement by recommending various changes to endorsement form basing on previous experience and input from members; which included the commercial declaration form, the scope and application of knowledge partner etc. Committee had tirelessly supported all endorsement applications by reaching out to the organizers and helping them to avail maximum benefits with a positive spirit.

### **Learning never stops in IOS:**

From March, 2020, as the country came under lockdown because of COVID -19, all physical academic activities were halted. During these challenging times, the idea of online learning via webinar using virtual platform was culminated. The endorsement committee stepped in for setting guidelines and speaker consent forms for the newly introduced era of the digital platform. The necessary changes in the endorsement application form was recommended and availed for regular application on IOS website. **Forty two programs** were endorsed by IOS during this COVID era; thus clearly justifies the theme "Learning never stops at IOS".

### **Orthobyte 2020- The first IOS virtual Conference**

IOS Research Foundation (IOS-RF) was established by Indian Orthodontic Society with due approval through 47<sup>th</sup> Annual General Body (AGM) meeting, which happened in the year 2012 (1.12.2012). The then President of IOS, Dr. Pradeep Chandra Shetty told the house that he initiated the project in an executive committee meeting in Vizag and the main aim was to popularize orthodontic research in the country of India. It was decided in that meeting that IOS

president and Hon. Secretary will be the ex-officio members of this research foundation. Currently there is a corpus of Rupees Eight lakhs and ninety-eight thousand Indian rupees (Rs. 8,98,000/-) in IOS-RF.

Currently, there are three grants approved for life as well as student members of Indian Orthodontic Society namely

1. **IOS RF---3M Unitek Grant for Research (Life Members)** – A grant of Rupees Fifty Thousand for original research projects will be allocated by the IOS Research Foundation.
2. **IOS RF---LOS Grant for Research(Life Members)** – A grant of Rupees Twenty-five thousand for original research projects in Lingual Orthodontics.
3. **IOS RF---Dr C Padmalatha Memorial Grant for Research(Student Members)** – A grant of Rupees Eight Thousand for original research projects will be allocated by the IOS Research Foundation.

#### **CURRENT COMMITTEE ACTIVITIES**

The IOS- RF sub-committee of the executive committee 2019-2020 laid down its objectives as;

1. Formulate grant application guidelines including timelines for inviting preliminary and final application as well as evaluations and application forms including MOU to be signed by grant recipients
2. Try to find the status of the website of IOS-RF and link it to existing IOS website so that online submission of grant proposals made possible
3. Try to obtain pending money from 3M unitek and find more funding sources for research foundation corpus (individuals and corporates)
4. Generate clarifications regarding exact sources of the money in the corpus fund and formulate exact grant amounts to be distributed
5. Try to get money from IOS budget each year for distribution as research grant

#### **Inviting proposals and research grant distribution**

A call for proposals from life as well as student members were sent out on 1<sup>st</sup> of March 2020 and IOS research foundation completed evaluation of primary and shortlisted final five research proposals. The following grants were released from IOS head office this year

#### **IOS-RF- 3M Unitek research grant for life members:**

Dr. Priyanka Kapoor (LM 1537) - Flow cytometric analysis of oral microbiome in orthodontic patients with obstructive sleep apnea – a comparative pilot study

#### **IOS-RF – Dr. C. Padmalatha memorial research grant for student life members:**

Dr. Akshay Mohan (SLM 9707) - Comparative evaluation of the short term skeletal and dentoalveolar effects of bone borne implant-supported rapid palatal expander with and without micro-osteo perforation in late adolescents- A prospective randomized clinical trial.

#### **Formulation of guidelines and application process**

The current committee procured all the details of activities of IOS-RF since its inception and compiled it as a document along with the necessary guidelines and application templates for future functioning and submitted to the head office.

2. Quality of research design
3. Policy impact
4. Academic impact
5. Engagement with local institutions
6. Value for money

The committee has developed a preliminary application form, final application form, Budget template, contract between principal investigator (PI) and the IOS head office, progress report and invoicing template, and completion of research form for smooth functioning of research foundation in the coming years.

**JIOS COMMITTEE REPORT**

**Editor – Dr. Puneet Batra**

The Covid-19 pandemic affected the working and functioning of several offices worldwide, but despite that all JIOS issues till date were upload on-time. A total of 100 articles including the various editorials and other articles were published till the April 2021 issue. The JIOS now has authorship spanning 17 countries (Turkey being the latest country to be represented). The maximum review time also saw an improvement and now stands at 56 days (including any need for 3<sup>rd</sup> reviewer scores). Due to the wonderful efforts of the JIOS and the publisher- SAGE; all articles pertaining to the COVID-19 pandemic published in the JIOS are now available on Pubmed Central (11 currently and 5 more are in the queue to be updated in the same). All relevant indexing applications (Pubmed, SCOPUS, WoS) were filed last year and in various stages of assessment and the results of the same are expected by the end of this year. 15 new national and international reviewers were inducted into the review board and the best reviewers were honored and facilitated at the JIOS symposium held during March 2021. In order to remove any unsolicited articles being submitted to the JIOS (a requirement for PMC indexing), as was previously done with the IBO case reports, the journal after approval for the IOS EC allowed for the submission of the IBO case report directly to the peer review system currently in place. In order to increase the transparency

of articles submitted to the JIOS, the journal has implemented an open data policy requiring authors if necessary to submit their original data in case of any dubiousness being suspected. The journal is also trying through the publisher to implement a transparent peer review system where each and every aspect is available openly to our respected authors. A promotional video highlighting the value and importance of continued support to the JIOS was also made for dissemination amongst IOS and international orthodontists for better reach and visibility of the journals as approved by the IOS EC.

The new Editorial Committee of IOS Times took charge by mid November 2019. The transfer of office from Dr Biju Abraham, the former editor of IOS Times to Dr M.S.Kannan, the present Editor of IOS Times was officially approved at the AGM of Indian Orthodontic Society, Bhubaneswar 2019.

Dr Kannan compiled his editorial team, which was approved by

the corresponding Executive Committee. Dr Sabarinathan was nominated as the Associate Editor for Year 2019-20. Dr Kavitha Iyer took his position as Associate Editor for the following year 2020- to current date. Dr Gaurav Gupta, Dr Ashish Garg, DrSwati Acharya from the corresponding executive committee and Dr Sandeep Singh as an external Member are serving as Section Editors till date.

As of date, IOS Times had published 18 issues. The IOS constitution stipulates to publish IOS Times as a Quarterly, i.e 4-issues/ year, which makes it up as 5 issues till date. The editorial committee had made a request to publish its issues as a monthly, beyond the constitution stipulated norms and the request was approved by the Executive committee. Thus 5 issues requisite till date was made as 18 issue publications. All these 18 issues were published on time, and on the last day of every month.

IOSTimes is an E publication and is available on various Social media platforms particularly the IOS website, IOS FB page and as Whats App forwards. We had measured the audience reach of IOS Times, and in the 18 months, there had been a 15 fold increase in viewership. The highest reach was recorded as 16,238 viewers on IOS FB Page. This included members from many International Orthodontic Associations and even the general public. Currently, many International Orthodontic associations and other Dental Specialty associations had been actively following IOS Times.

All the issues covered IOS Activities under sections, Head Office events, Study Group events, Public Awareness campaign and materials, IOS Senior members and IOS Celebrity interviews, CoVid awareness articles and interviews from experts, cross word puzzles, student sections, Braces Artist contests, Obituary sections and more. As of date Ormco India is the only exclusive sponsor for the publications. IOSTimes had managed expenditure by raising its own funds and generated surplus for the society funds.

The IOS management committee on the recommendation from MBP subcommittee and approval from 54th AGM officially launched two benefit programmes for IOS Life Members during this term.

The two schemes included

### **1. IOS CARE - A Member Welfare Program**

The nominee of the IOS Life Members shall receive a sum of Rupees Two lakhs in an unfortunate event of demise of the member. This is a member welfare policy wherein the family of the deceased is paid this amount as a gesture of goodwill, a helping hand to the family and to send a message that the Society cares for its members.

THIS INVOLVES NO CONTRIBUTION FROM THE MEMBER

### **2. IOS PROTECT- Professional Indemnity Scheme.**

IOS had tied up with 'The New India Assurance Company' for the 'Professional Indemnity Scheme'. It is a master Indemnity policy issued in the name of Indian Orthodontic Society and covers only members registered under the scheme. This scheme involves an annual premium of a nominal amount and requires to be renewed every year.

### **IOS PROTECT**

Planning for the scheme started way back from the previous term of 2018-19. A separate Policy Document was drafted by the Committee in consultation with the competent authorities and inputs from the Executive Committee of 2018-19 and 2019-20.

New India assurance company was recommended by the committee based on the attractive offer and company's reputation. The offer was finalised for a cover of 20 lakhs in a ratio of 1:4. The premium was negotiated for 1000+tax/ member /year  
The EC approved the same during the 4th ECM (2018-19) at Jaipur

**First Batch (March 2020)**

Registrations for IOS PROTECT Commenced from January 2020. The first batch comprising of 132 members enrolled for the scheme and the coverage commenced for them from 23/03/2020. (List and Policy Copy attached)

The Policy copy was received during the second week of April 2020 and the same along with the Policy Document and Coverage clause was sent to all registered Members by E mail on 13/04/2020

**Second Batch (January 2021)**

A set of 12 new members enrolled for the scheme in January 2021. A new group policy for them was started as the second batch with the same features as the first batch. The Coverage commenced from 13/01/2021 (List and Policy Copy attached)

**Renewal of First Batch (March 2021)**

The professional Indemnity policy by IOS covering 132 members successfully completed one year of coverage on 23/03/2021. From MBP subcommittee communications were made from February itself to all 132 members for renewal of the policy by E-mail, messages and phone calls. Also the Committee reached out to all members for additional new Enrollments. 145 applications were received comprising both Renewal and new enrollments. This included 107 out of 132 from the previous year and 38 new members. (List and Policy copy attached) Renewal forms and new enrollment forms from old and new members respectively were received. The premium (1077 INR by each member) was transferred by members directly to the IOS Bank account. A consolidated cheque for a sum of Rs156165 was handed over to the Insurance provider (The New India Assurance company Ltd). The coverage for the new/ renewed policy started from 23/03/2021. The copy of the policy was received on April 15 th. A soft copy of the policy was sent to all registered members by mail on 17/04/2021. As on date IOS PROTECT extends its coverage in two batches - main batch in March for 145 members and additional batch in December/January for 12 members.

**Third batch (August /September 2021)**

Registrations for the third Batch (August/September 2021) have started already and will end on 31st of August 2021. The coverage shall commence from the first week of September 2021.

**IOS CARE**

Policy Document and Application for IOS CARE PROGRAM was drafted and finalised after consultation with competent authorities and suggestions from President, Secretary, POBs and EC. Registration process for the same was planned online through IOS Website and the loop for the same was created by the web master. A registration certificate was designed and option for downloading it after verification and approval was created in our website. The certificate will be an acknowledgement of registration to the program. Registrations were first opened for EC members as a trial and the feedback to simplify the application process were taken and incorporated. On July 15 a communication from the HO was sent to all members inviting them to register for the same. A promotional/awareness presentation was done by the committee chairman on 22/08/2020 during the ILLUMINATI Series to educate the members on the registration process of IOS Care. A Promotional video was released by the subcommittee during the second of May 2021 for IOS CARE. The video was

well received by members in all social media platforms and served the purpose of creating Awareness about the scheme. As of 15<sup>th</sup> August 2021 we have 200 successful registrations for IOS CARE.

#### **Status of the Old MBP scheme**

The subcommittee reached out to all 54 existing members of the old scheme by email with options for refund of the registration amount paid by them or to redirect the funds to be utilized in the subscription to IOS PROTECT Scheme. 22 Members opted to redirect the funds for subscription to IOS PROTECT for 2019-20. 20 Members wanted to continue with IOS PROTECT for the year 2020-21 as well during renewal. (Both List attached) Refund was made to five members of old scheme on request with the approval of the EC. (List attached)

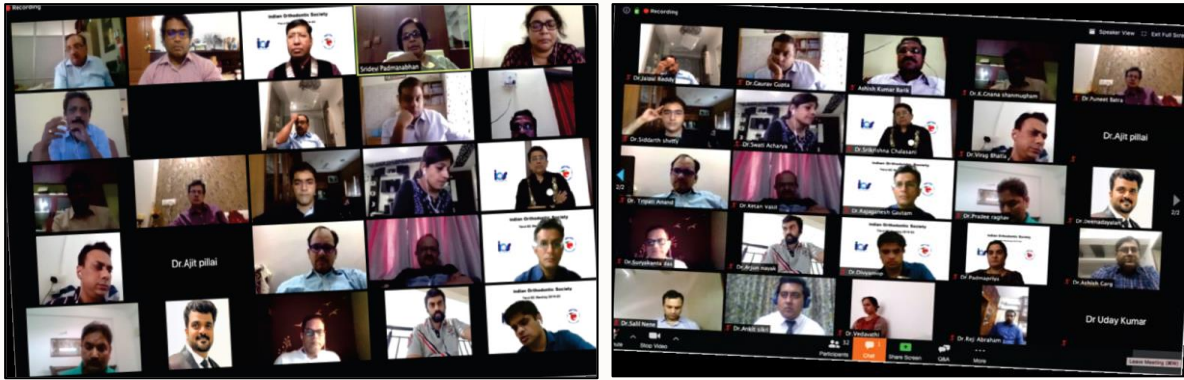
### **3<sup>rd</sup> EXECUTIVE MEETING OF INDIAN ORTHODONTIC SOCIETY**

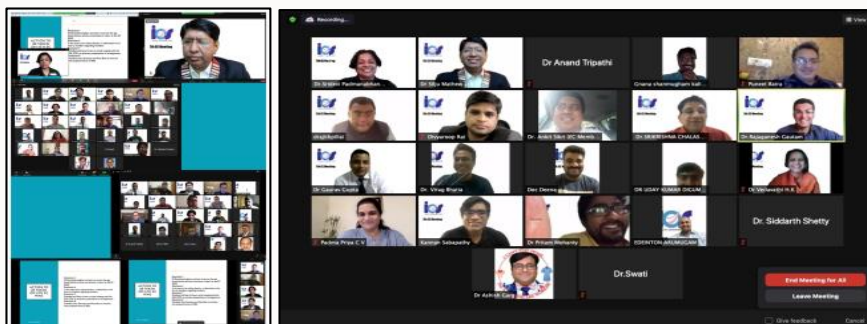

### CONFLUENCE 2020

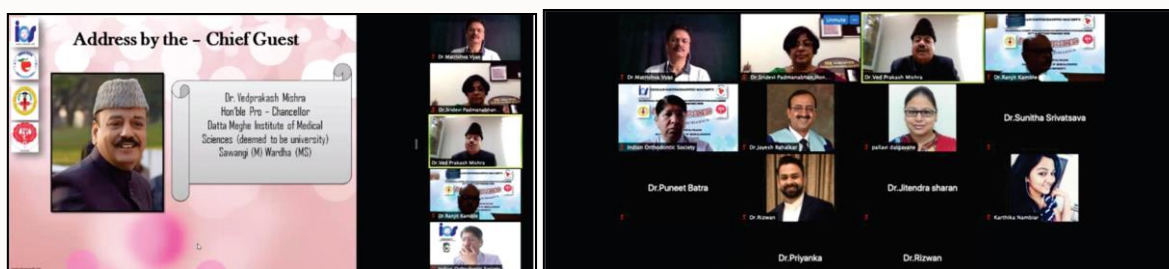

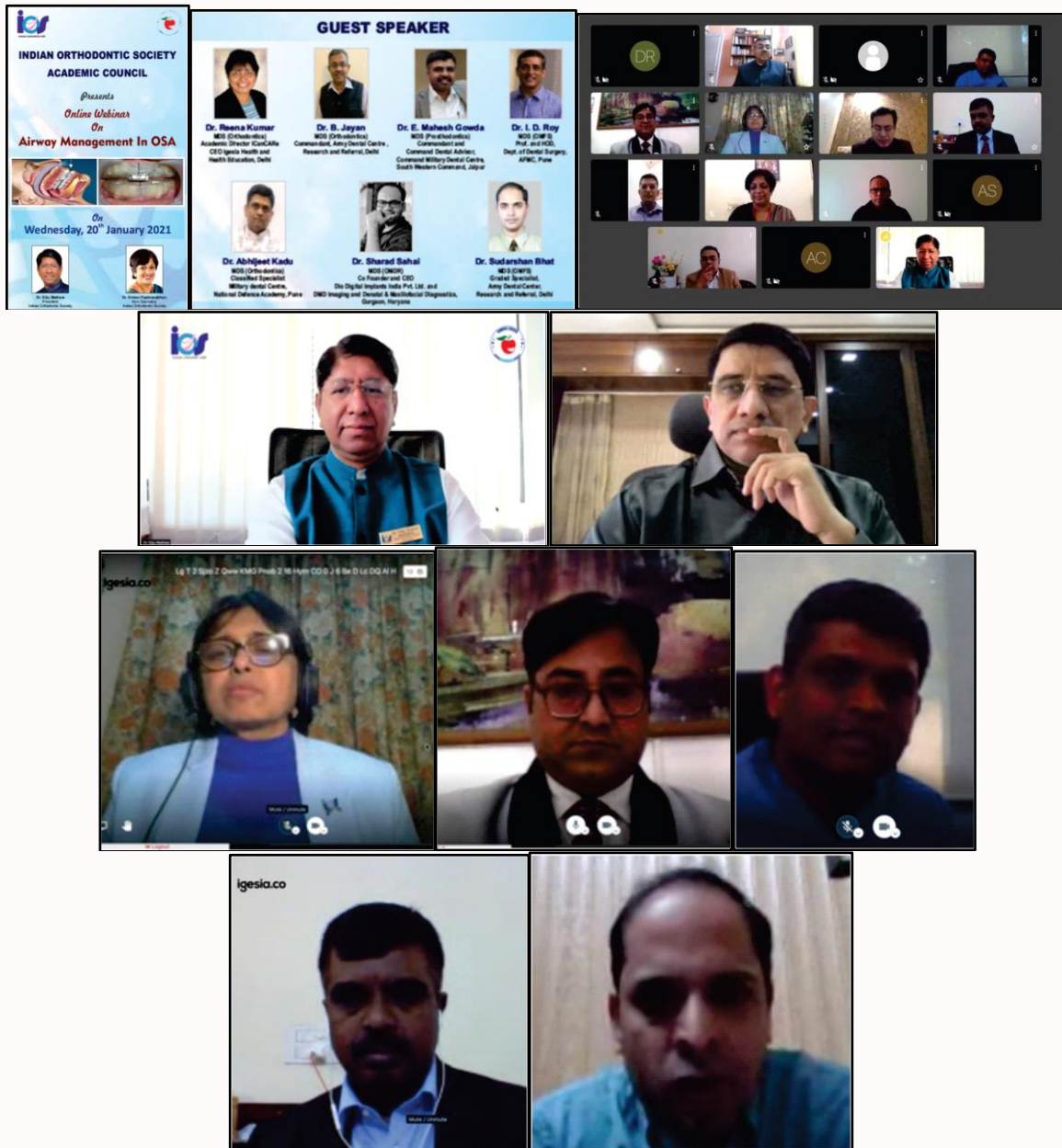

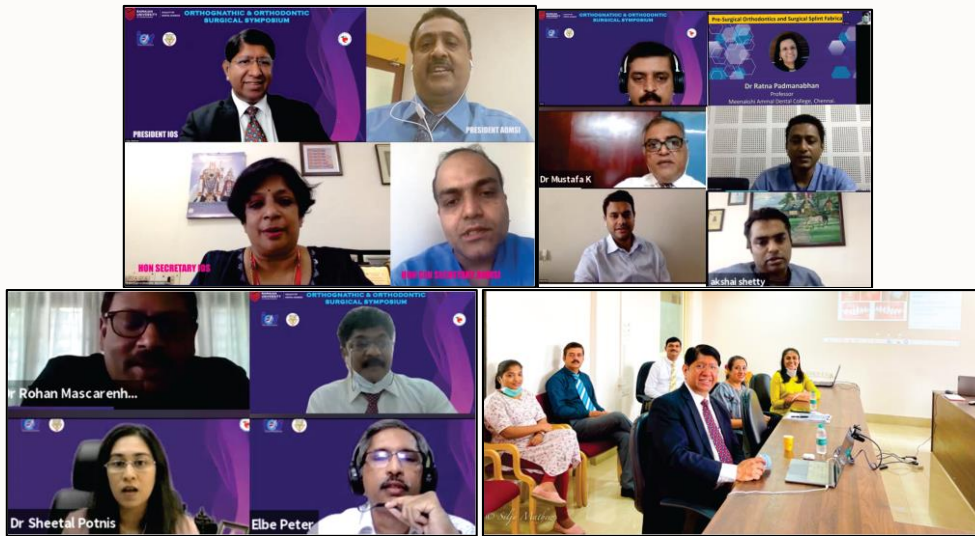
### ROAR 2021

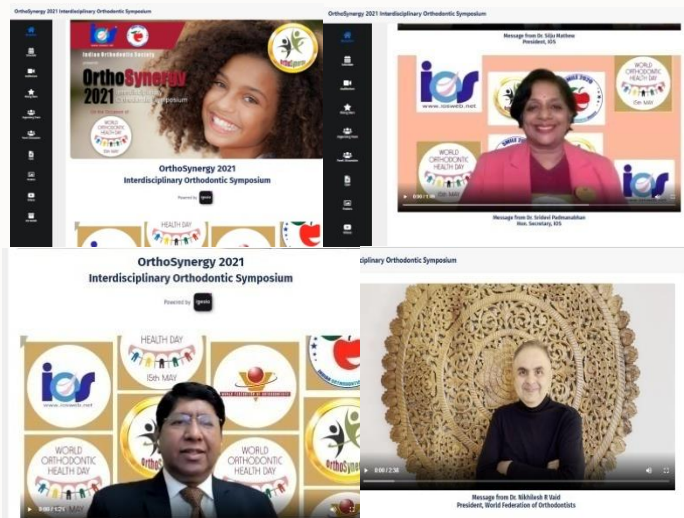

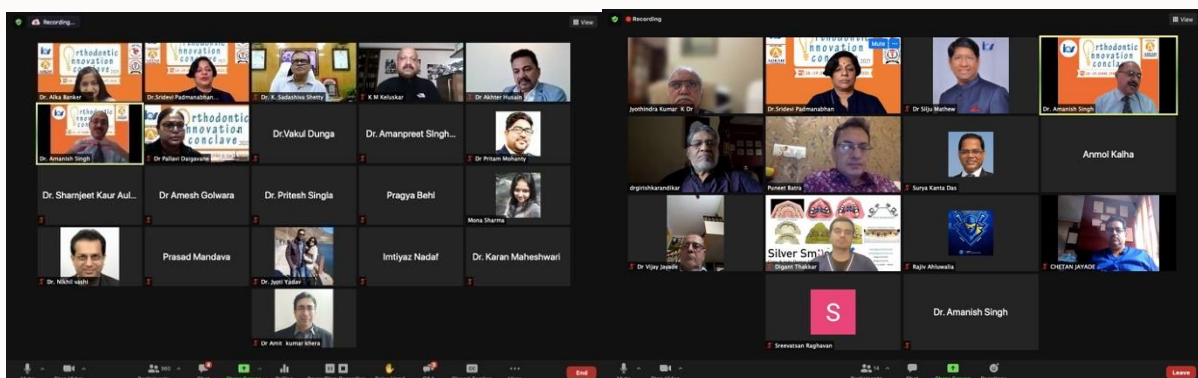

## IOS "ORTHO ILLUMINATI" INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR SERIES

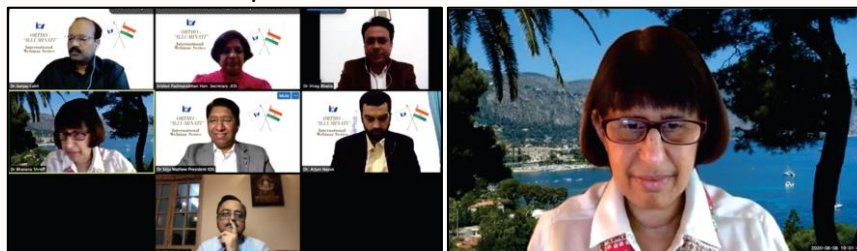

## **INDIAN BOARD OF ORTHODONTICS – ANNUAL REPORT**

### **Greetings from the Board of Directors, IBO**

We are all living in unprecedented times and this pandemic has necessitated a change in the mode of operations with the various activities of the IBO. The team of Directors under the able chairmanship of Dr Ketan Vakil has tried our best to see that the events and programs of the Indian Board of Orthodontics (IBO) have not been stalled in any manner due to various restrictions caused by the pandemic.

The Convocation of the IBO, the last of the physical meetings till date was held at Bhubaneshwar on the 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2019 and the Chief Guest for that program was Dr. Kee Joon Lee from SouthKorea. Dr.Lee conveyed a very inspiring and motivating message about the importance to improve the standards of orthodontic care to patients. This pandemic also brought about the need for many firsts and some novel, bold initiatives had to be taken by the Board. It all started with the need to make a last minute cancellation of the first IBO Awareness programs scheduled to be held on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> March 2020 at Ahmedabad due to sudden travel restrictions imposed by the government in the wake of the COVID pandemic, The Awareness programs are usually conducted twice a year at a specified location, with the main objective to educate and encourage the IOS members to get Board Certified.

The Board then made a decision to conduct the IBO Awareness program on an online mode for the first time. Being conducted on an online mode, it was possible to conduct the Awareness program at a National level with participants from all over the country. We had a record breaking number of around 500 participants on the first day and around 350 on the second day. The Board also decided to conduct the IBO Phase II written examinations on an online mode. The conduct of the Phase II examinations was outsourced to an organisation known as the NSE IT (The IT partner of the National Stock exchange.) A total of 24 centers spread across all the states in the country were selected. This move reduced the burden of candidates travelling large distances, saving time and expenses especially with regard to travelling restrictions due to the ongoing Pandemic. A record breaking total of 332 candidates had applied for the Phase II examinations. All precautions with regard to Covid necessary protocol were undertaken. The huge success of the online mode of Phase II examinations with more than 100% increase in the number of candidates from the previous years proved that this approach would be an ideal way for the future.

The work for creating an IBO index which grades the degree of difficulty and improvement of cases submitted for the Phase III examination was initiated. This index prioritizes the need to include malocclusion prevalent to our population in contrast to other International Indices. The work of creating an IBO website was also initiated, this website would be an online portal with all relevant information and resources related to IBO for candidates who aspire to take up Board certification. Additionally the website shall also attempt to describe the conceptualization, creation, structure, mission and vision of our Board as well showcase the importance, value and efforts behind Board certification in specialty dental practice.

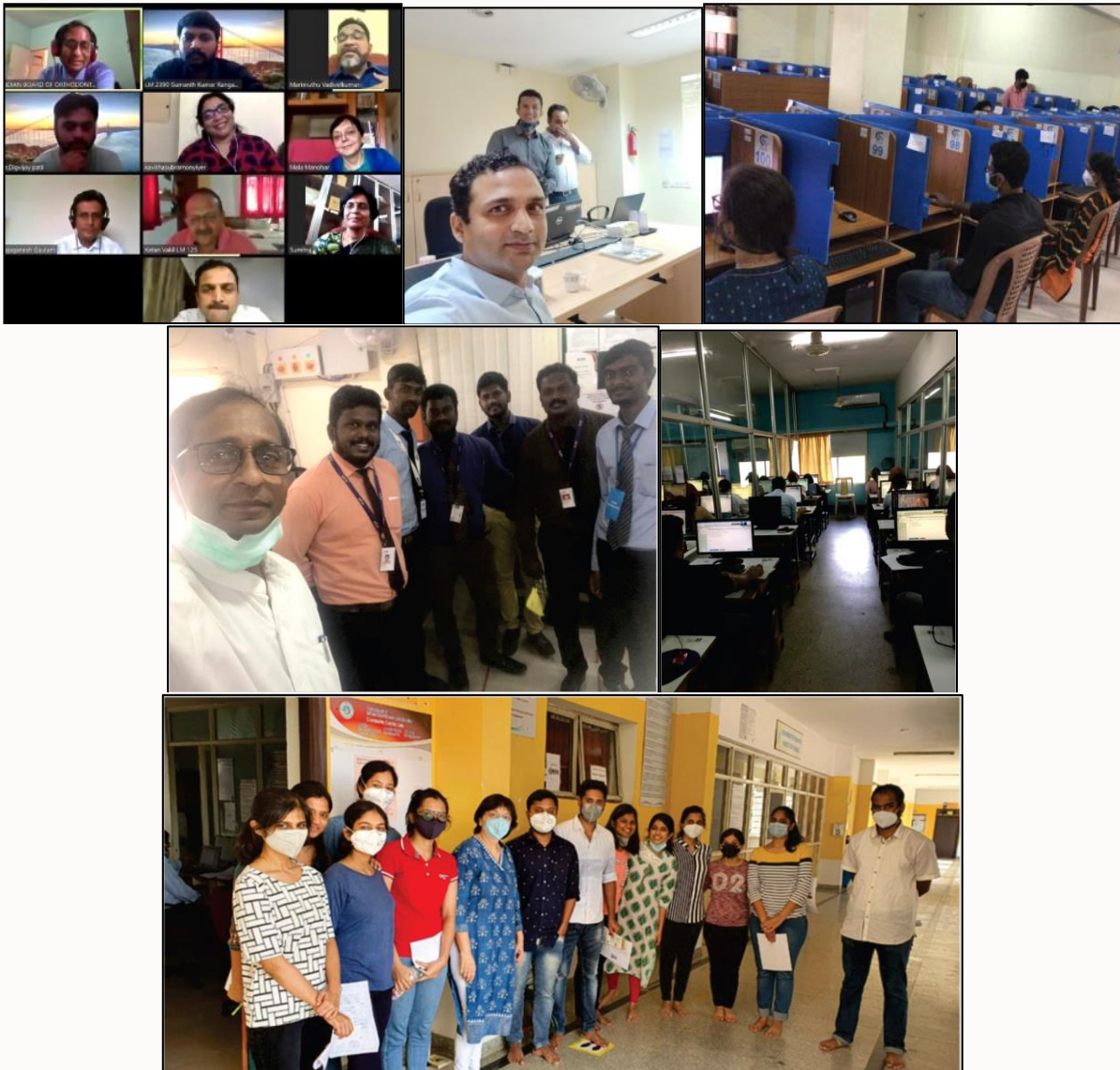
The Board took a noble step to help the nation and its people devastated in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic. The Board felt that it was the need of the hour and contributions in the

### MANGALORE ORTHODONTIC STUDY GROUP

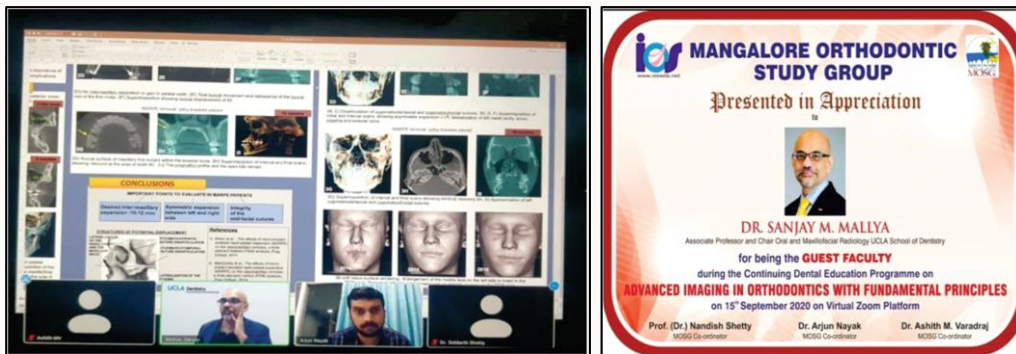

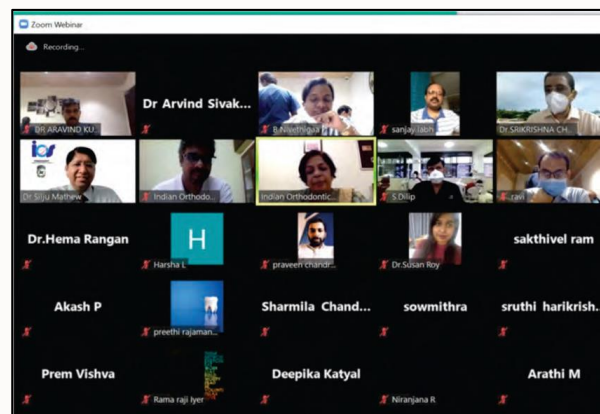
**Tads 360 Physical Conference On Temporary Anchorage Devices 30-31<sup>st</sup> March 31, 2021.**

**ORTHO FEST 2020**

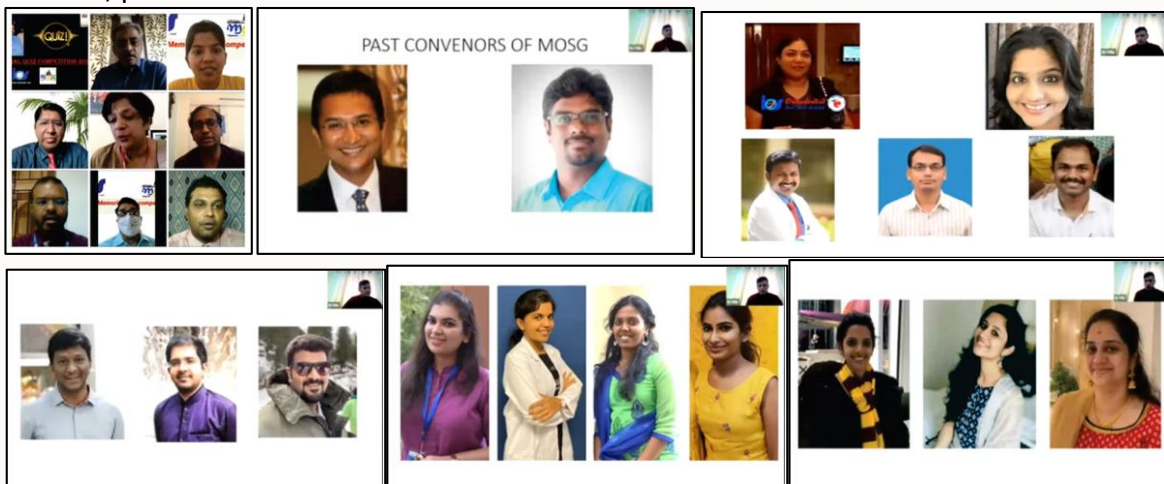

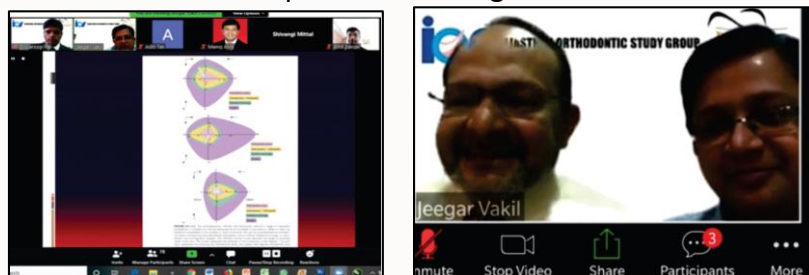
**RAJASTHAN ORTHODONTIC STUDY GROUP (ROSG)**

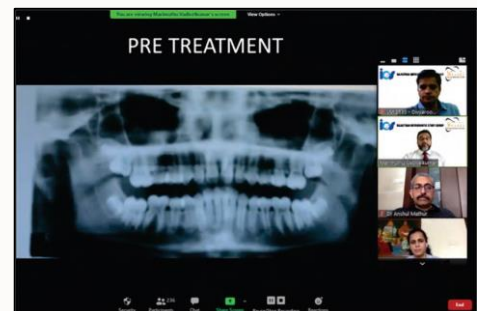
### **Rajasthan Orthodontic Study Group (ROSG)**

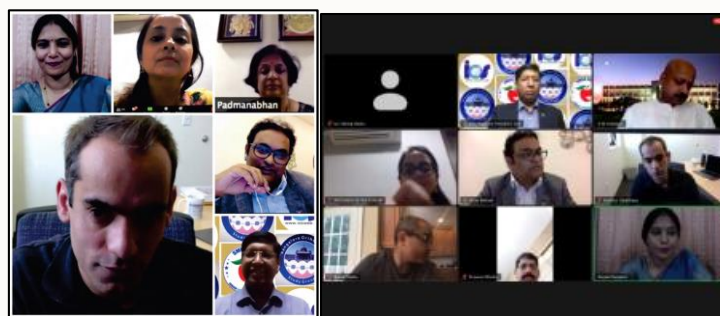

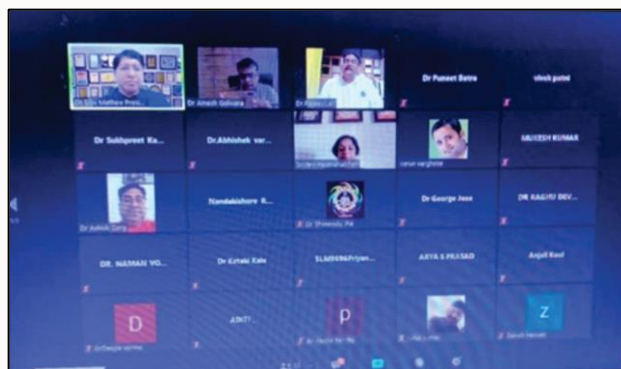

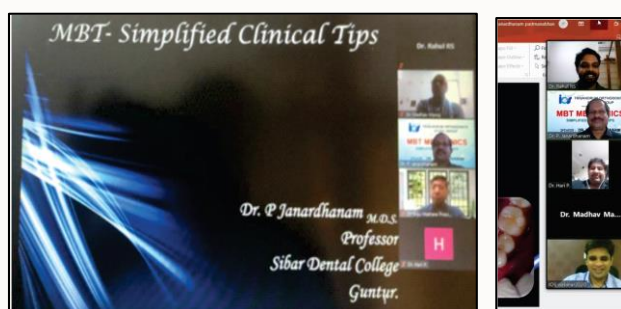

was made by Dr.Silju Mathew, President IOS, followed by felicitations by Faculty and Convenors. Meeting was concluded at 7.45 .00 pm.

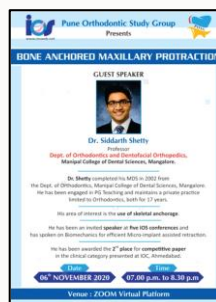
### ANDHRA PRADESH ORTHODONTIC STUDY GROUP

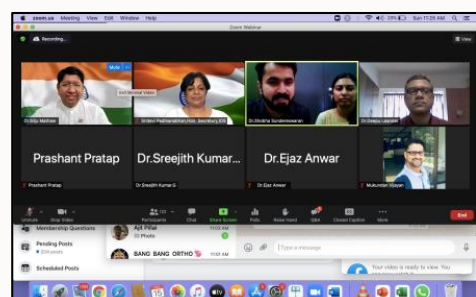

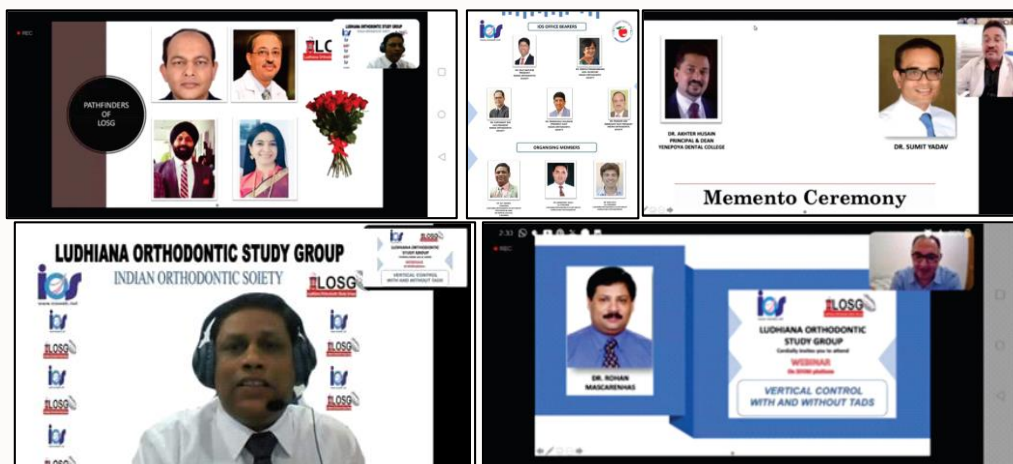
### WEBINAR FROM LUDHIANA ORTHODONTIC STUDY GROUP

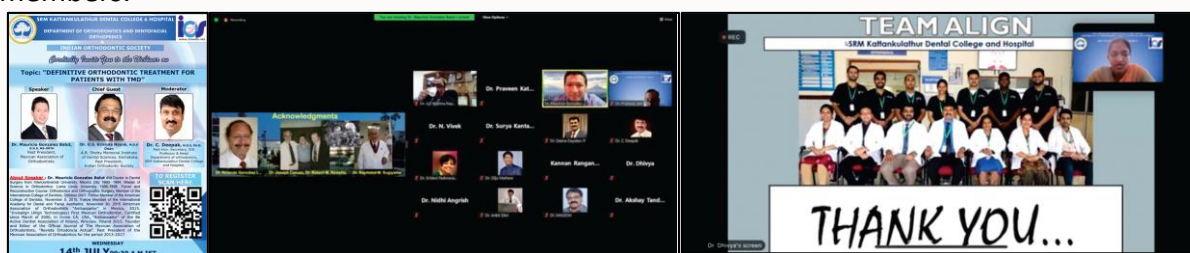
### “Lingual Orthodontics Workshop” By Hitkarini Dental College And Hospital, Jabalpur

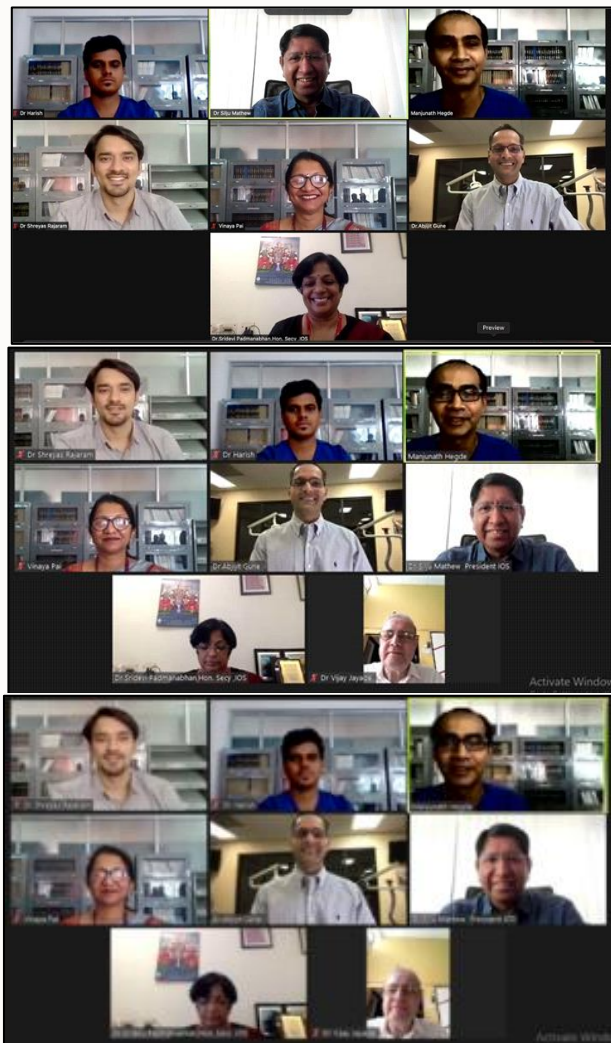

It was a great learning experience on the best practices of each speciality, inter-speciality cooperation and synergies.

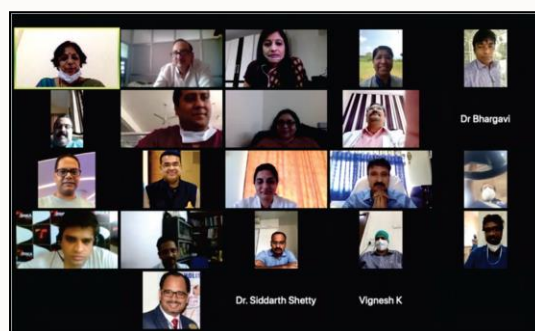




### IOS GETS IT OWN DEDICATED OFFICE

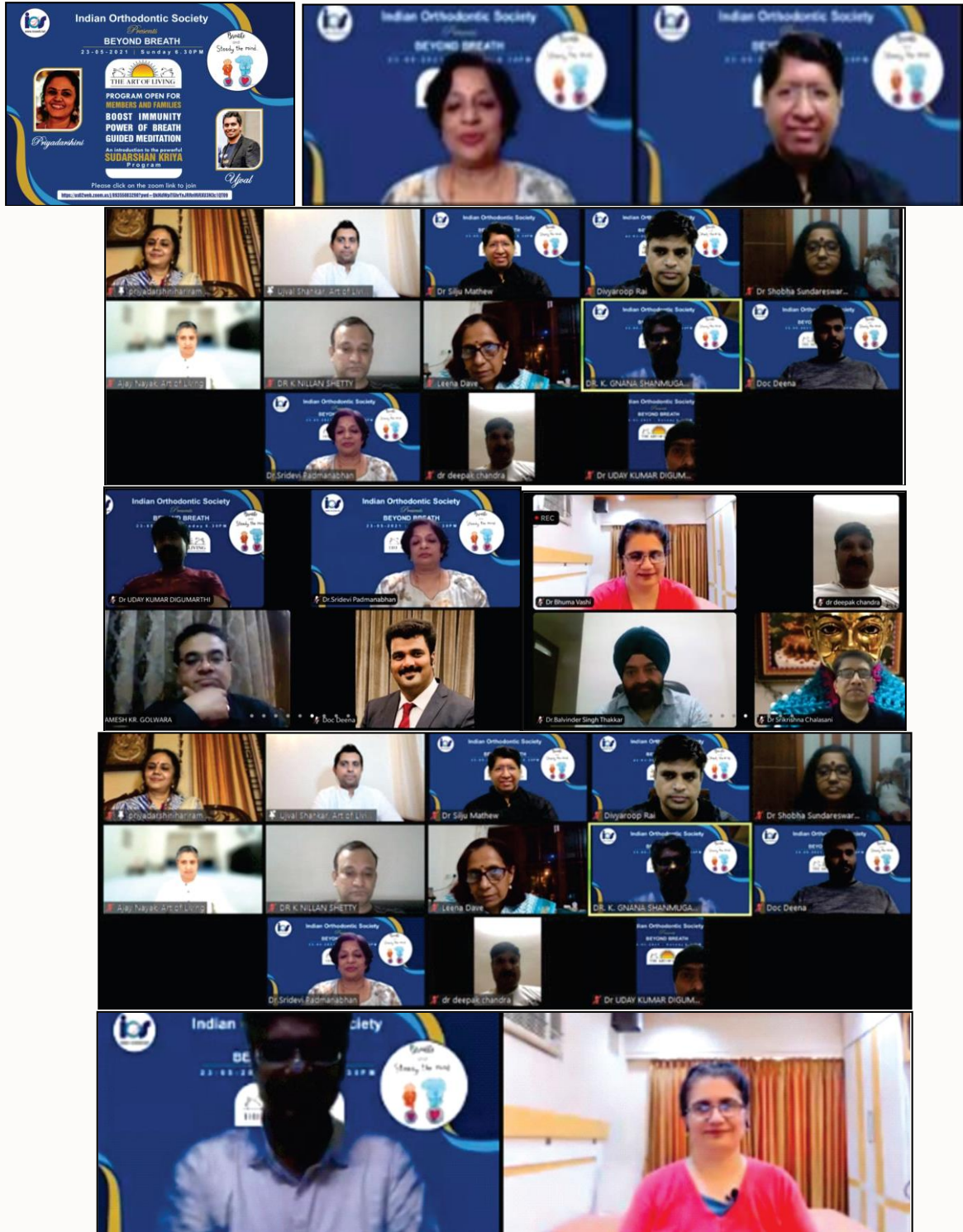

### BEYOND BREATH A VIRTUAL MEDITATION SESSION – 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2021

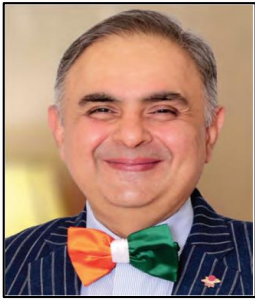

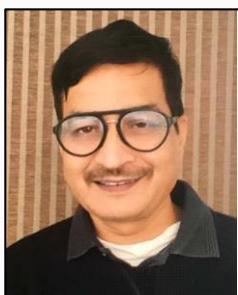

**DR. AVINASH NAWATHE, GUJARAT**



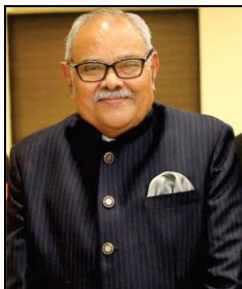

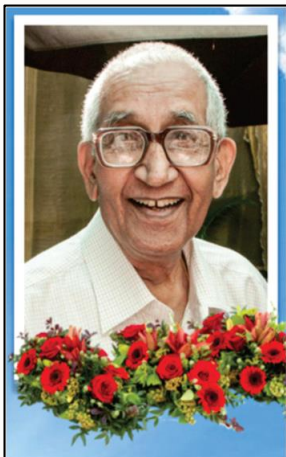

He was a terror with his pipe in mouth and asking questions, but was patient and listened carefully to the answers given by the student. I shall say that he was instrumental in 3 of us passing as the first batch from GDC Bangalore. From the time I passed, he was very friendly with me. I heard that he was an excellent Teacher and Clinician from my batch mates in Nair Dental College, Mumbai. Dr. Parikh's journey into Orthodontic Society began prior to 1962. He was instrumental in getting the Bombay Orthodontic Study Group established in 1962, which met

regularly for clinical case presentation and discussion of treatment plans to further their knowledge in Orthodontics. The founder members of IOS were the members of the Bombay Orthodontic Study Group and Dr. Naishadh Parikh was Secretary. The Bombay Orthodontic Study Group paved the way for the formation of the Indian Orthodontic Society in 1965. Dr. Parikh was chosen unanimously as the Founder Secretary and Treasurer of Indian

Orthodontic Society for a term of 2 years, and was re-elected 3 more terms covering a period of 8 years during 1965 to 1973. In 1973, he took over the mantle as President of the Indian Orthodontic Society for 1973 to 1975. During this tenure he also served as the President of Indian Dental Association during 1974-1975, thus becoming the first person to occupy the position of President of two dental associations in India. During his tenure as the Founder Secretary and Treasurer of Indian Orthodontic Society. He is credited with establishing the following:

1. The constitution of the Indian Orthodontic Society was drafted by him which is still in vogue, of course with various amendments required as per the changing times. He also played a pivotal role in the drafting of the Constitution of Indian Dental Association.
2. Dr. Parikh was meticulous in recording of the minutes and his maintenance of Office records was extra ordinary – particularly the Bound Books of Management Committees and Annual General Body Meetings of IOS. Both the minutes books, which he used to carry for all meetings for 8 years, were duly signed by the President in the next meeting. This served as an inspiration for me and many others. The records were handwritten originally, typed and pasted later and still later with computer print outs. The first two original Bound Books of Management Committees and Annual General Body Meetings of IOS are well preserved and are available in IOS Office.
3. Dr. Parikh had excellent memory and can quote verbatim from both IOS and IDA constitutions. Members used to ask him for clarifications in the constitution and referred to the books only when he was not present in the meetings, which was very rare.
4. Dr. Parikh was a strict disciplinarian, adhered and respected the rules while conducting the meetings or participating. He always welcomed suggestions and implemented them if it is beneficial to the profession. He supported all progressive decisions of IOS and helped to implement them.
5. Dr. Parikh was a jovial person outside meetings and led a well-mannered social life. He was Dr. Parikh to all and Naishad for his friends. His wife Vrinda and children Neha and Nirav supported him in all his endeavours in the orthodontic and dental profession.
6. At this point of time, I would love to place on record that whatever I learnt from Naishad on rules and procedures, I tried to follow them scrupulously and I assure you that it was highly beneficial to me in my professional career and in my various administrative assignments.

It is to be etched in golden words that it is Dr. Parikh who laid the foundation for establishment of the Indian Orthodontic Society, as the first dental specialist Association in India, drafted the IOS Constitution, and strictly adhered to the maintenance of Office records and procedures, thereby building IOS what it is today. On his demise, the Indian Orthodontic Society has lost a doyen of Indian Orthodontics

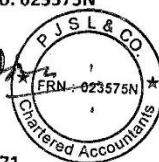

Significant Accounting Policies & Notes to Accounts:

**a. Basis of Preparation:**

The financial statements have been prepared under historic cost convention on accrual basis.

**Note -1 Significant accounting policies:**

Significant Accounting Policies & Notes to Accounts:

**a. Basis of Preparation:**

The financial statements have been prepared under historic cost convention on accrual basis.

**b. Fixed Assets:**

Fixed Assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and depreciation is provided on WDV method as per rate prescribed under Income Tax Rules.

**c. Taxation on Income:**

Income Tax liability computed annually after considering tax allowances and exemptions. The Income tax liabilities on Life Membership contribution has not been considered because of concept of "doctrine of mutuality".

Indian Orthodontic Society is a group of people who form an association and pool in funds which are referred to as common funds for the working of the association, hence, the amount generated is no longer regarded as income and therefore not subject to any income tax.

**d. Revenue Recognition:**

Revenue has been recognized on Receipts basis except Interest on FDR's.

**e. Provision and Contingent Liabilities/Assets:**

Provisions involving substantial degree of estimation in measurement are recognised when there is a present obligation as a result of past events and it is probable that there will be an outflow of resources. These are reviewed at each balance sheet date and adjusted to reflect the current best estimates.

**f. Liabilities/Assets:**


